Concept Reinforcement Sample Answers

1. **Where would you look to locate information about the Renaissance in a book entitled *A Complete History of England*?**

The best place to locate information about the Renaissance would be in the table of contents.

2. **How can you determine the meaning of the word *onomatopoeia* in a literature textbook?**

The best place to locate definitions for key terms is in the glossary, but you may also be able to locate definitions in the footnotes.

3. **What text structure should be used to write an essay entitled “Factories and the Environment”?**

The best text structure for this essay would be a cause-and-effect structure. An essay with this title will most likely address the effects that factory pollution has on the environment.

4. **Why would you look for subheadings in an article about planting vegetables when trying to find information about planting rutabagas?**

If you were only looking for information specifically related to rutabagas, you would want to locate a subheading that indicates that all of the information below the heading will pertain to that specific topic.
